Early Copy-Editing Experiment

- 3 of 6 documents edited during Sept. and Oct. 2005 have entered the RFC Editor queue
- I of those 3 has been published as an RFC
- In general, there are a few pages of added text and a few pages of deleted text between the early edit version and approved version.
- Second reading yields edits to old text and new text.
- More benefit during AUTH48 than regular EDIT (based on one AUTH48 so far).
