From the [Online Portion of the Style Guide](#):

The <u> element is required for cases where the non-ASCII characters are needed for correct protocol operation.

Example of <u> output: "ש" (HEBREW LETTER SHIN, U+05E9)

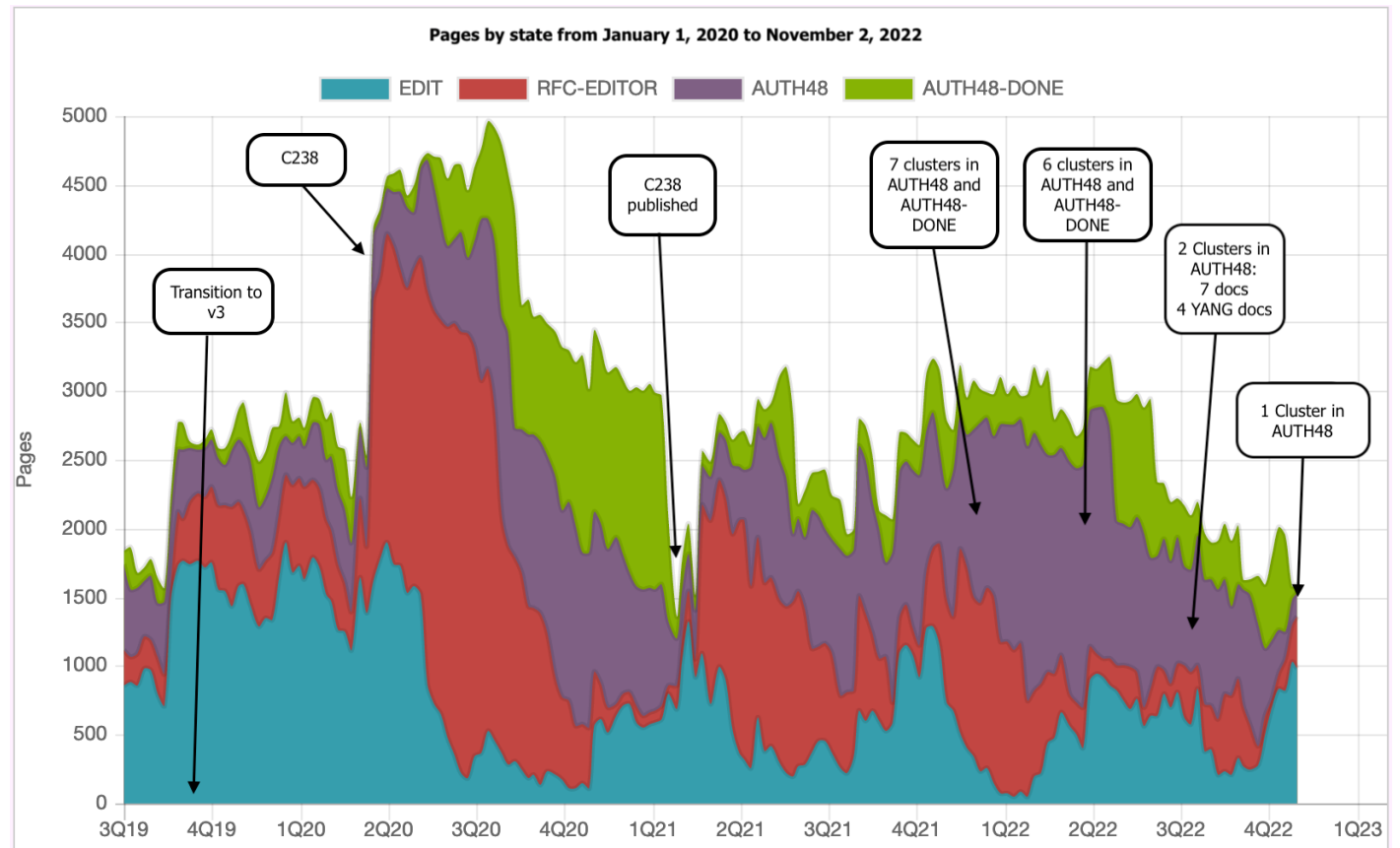

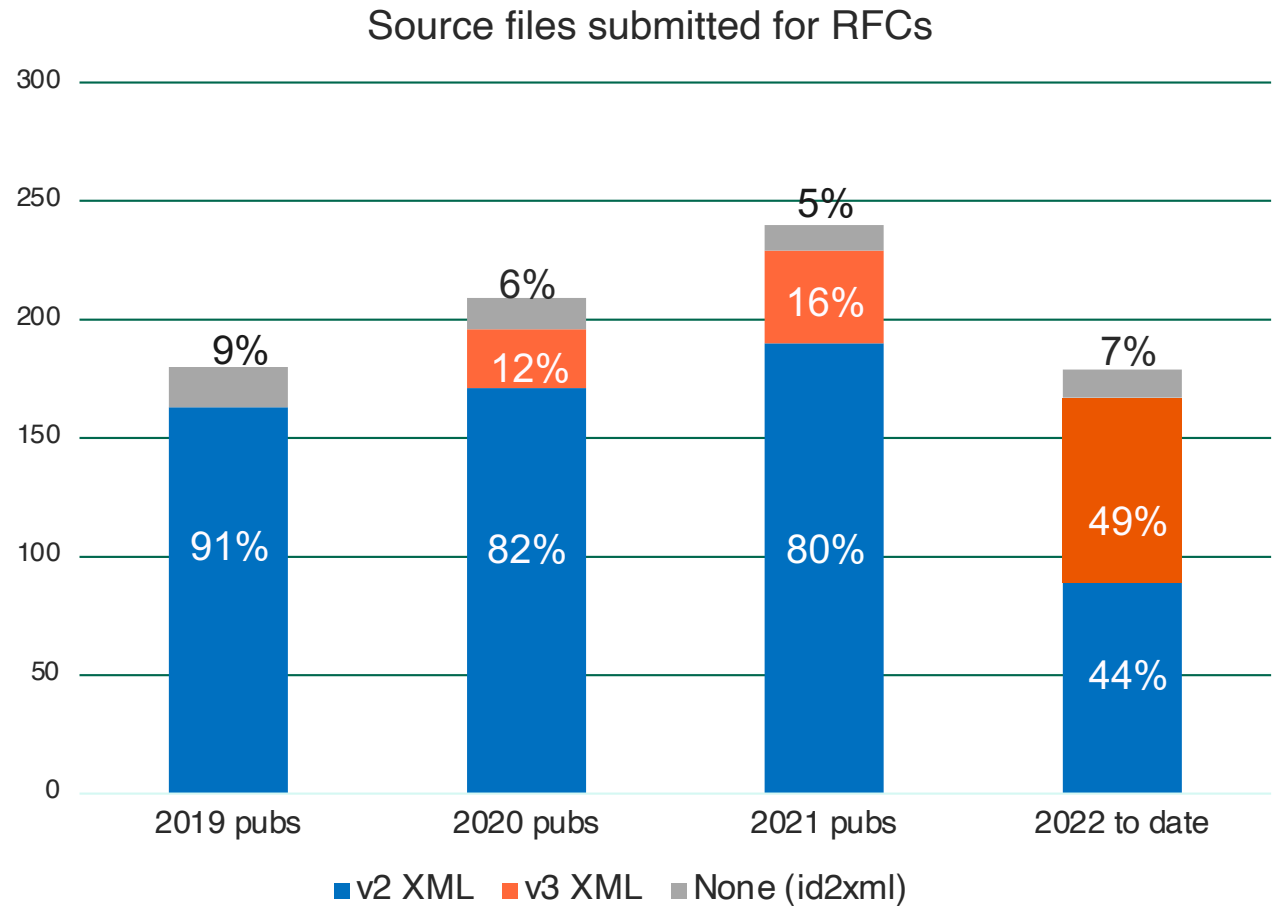

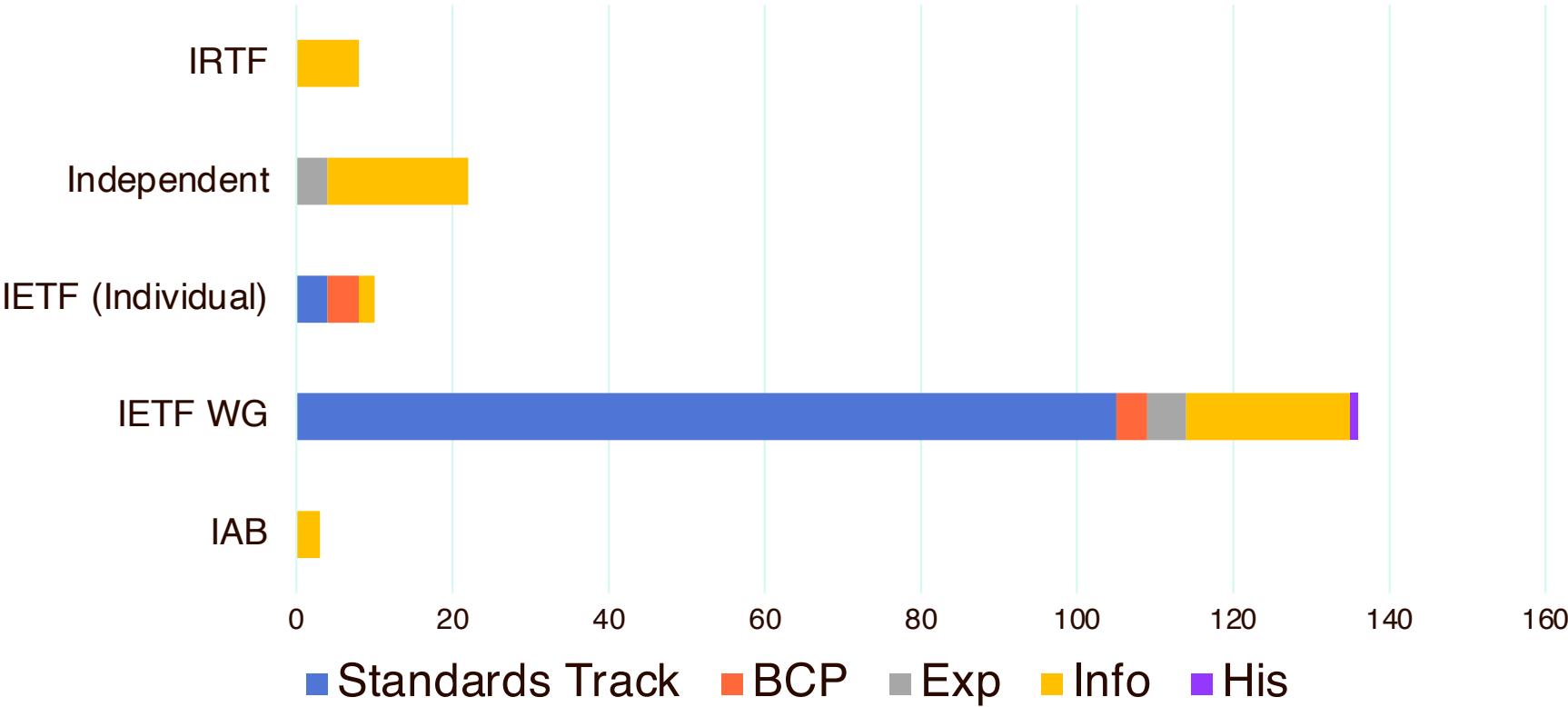
Queue Breakdown: pages by state
