1 The varwidth environment

The package defines a varwidth environment (based on minipage) which is an analogue of minipage, but whose resulting width is the natural width of its contents. A trivial example:

\begin{varwidth}{1in}	and	\begin{minipage}{1in}
Trivia		Trivia
$\end{varwidth}$		\end{minipage}

which produces

Trivia and Trivia

(the output placed in an \pm to emphasise the effect).

2 The \marrowragged command

The command works like **\raggedright**, but produces generally narrowe lines in paragraphs, with more text in the last line (the lines have more-equal lengths).
